Foundational Concepts to Skills-Based Approaches

- A job is a bundle of tasks that require a set of skills to complete.
- Better information leads to better outcomes.



What is the Occupational Mobility Explorer?


- The Occupational Mobility Explorer (OME) is an interactive tool that allows users to explore career paths and visualize how overlapping skillsets can facilitate upward mobility from lower-paying to higher-paying jobs in over 500 US locations and across 600+ job titles.
- A “career navigation system” that combines public and proprietary labor market data.
 - The 2023 occupation-specific information (wage, location, and projections) is from the Bureau of Labor Statistics.
 - Top 25 skills requested by employers in online job ads for each occupation at the state level; 2,300+ unique skills representing employer demand (Lightcast).
 - Some of the occupation connections are obvious (e.g., licensed practical nurse to registered nurse), others less so (e.g., motorboat mechanics to industrial engineering technologist).




How does the OME work?

- Each pair of occupations has a similarity score, based on the degree of overlap and the skill intensity of a pair's top 25 skills.
- In the tool, we classify skill similarity scores for each pair of occupations as high, medium, and low.
- Tool presents the 10 higher- (or lower-) paying occupations with the highest skill similarity score for each occupation.






A barrier low-income families may face when working to improve their economic mobility. Also known as the “cliff effect,” a benefits cliff occurs when career advancement puts a family above the income eligibility threshold for public assistance and the family is financially worse off than before the wage increase.
